

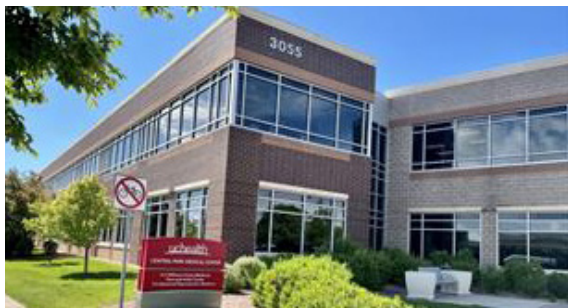

Clinical Research

Our Center conducts many clinical trials and research studies, including sponsored drug trials and observational studies. Our clinical research includes studies of:

- Healthy Adult Volunteers
- Adults with Alzheimer's disease
- Adults with Frontotemporal dementia
- Adults with Posterior Cortical Atrophy
- Adults with Lewy Body dementia
- Adults with Mild Cognitive Impairment
- Adults with Down Syndrome

Laboratory and Translational Research

CU Alzheimer's and Cognition Center Researchers conduct laboratory and animal research studies as a part of Dr. Huntington Potter's lab. Some current projects include:

- ApoE-targeted therapies for Alzheimer's (AD)
- Biomarkers in AD and Down Syndrome (DS)
- GM-CSF to treat AD, DS, traumatic brain injury, viral diseases, and normal aging
- Cerebral organoids to study AD and DS

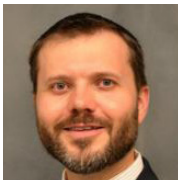
